Announcement of the appointment of our new Incumbent. It is wonderful to be able to let you know that it was announced on Sunday 16th April that our new Priest in charge is to be the Reverend Neil Bowler. Neil is currently the Rector of the Wykeham Benefice in North Oxfordshire, but before that he was in the Sheffield Diocese, since his ordination in 2005. Neil was born and grew up in a coal mining village in Rotherham, South Yorkshire, and was a lawyer for 10 years before ordination. As well as being an incumbent he has held a number of roles within the church, including being an Honorary Canon of Sheffield cathedral, the Bishop of Sheffield's advisor in spirituality, the Area dean of Rotherham, to name just a few.

Revd. Neil has sent a message to everyone here at Bridlington Priory.

'It is a privilege for me to be asked to come and to be your Priest in Bridlington. I'm looking forward so much to being with you and getting to know you all. To lead the church and the parish together, to live out the Gospel in Bridlington, with a smile and in joy.'

Revd Neil's licensing service will be on Thursday 27th July at 7.30pm at which Bishop Eleanor will preside. More details to follow, but save the date, as everyone is invited. Let us hold Revd Neil in our prayers as he prepares for his move to Bridlington.
